## EXEMPLARY PRACTICE: DISCOVERY TRAILS ONLINE SCHOOL — ONLINE LEARNING SUPPORTS

#### **Project Description**

Staff at Discovery Trails Online School, the division's Grade 1-9 online offering, have developed strategies to provide enhanced supports for students' social and emotional needs.
